Topic: **SRC ELECTIONS 2019**

This memorandum serves to communicate to staff and students the state of affairs with regards to the Student Representative Council (SRC).

In terms of Section 26 of the Standard College Statute (Schedule 1 of the Continuing Education and Training (CET) Act 16 of 2006), the term of office of the members of the SRC must be one academic year.

After numerous attempts to have SRC elections without success for the past 2 years, it has been decided by the College Management to dissolve the 10 remaining members of the initial 72 with immediate effect, as this is in contradiction to the CET Act as stipulated above.

As per Department of Higher Education and Training (DHET) policy, the College is expected to have newly elected SRC by Mid-March of each year. The elections of the SRC must be democratic and transparent and they will be conducted according to Section D of the approved Constitution.

All qualifying students are encouraged to participate in the upcoming SRC elections which will take place on 27 February 2019.
