#### RESULTING AND REGISTRATION OF STUDENTS FOR NATED REPORT 190/1 N1-N6 PROGRAMMES

Memorandum 49 of 2015 has reference.

The Department is still unable to release the results for the November 2015 examinations cycle due to processing errors which persist on the examinations IT system which is programmed and maintained by the State Information Technology Agency. Please be assured that this matter is receiving priority attention and that the Department is doing everything within its power to resolve the challenge.

To ensure that tuition can start without delay on 18 January 2016, colleges are hereby advised to enrol all candidates who wrote subjects in the November 2015 examinations on the next level per subject for tuition purposes. These candidates will be permitted to write a subject on two levels in the April and June 2016 examinations cycles respectively should they fail any of the subjects written in November 2015.

All examination centres will receive these outstanding results within the next week and before the closing date for registration for examinations in the first trimester (01 February 2016) and the first semester (19 February 2016) of 2016 and will therefore be in a position to register candidates on the correct level(s) per subject for these examination cycles.

The closing date for submission of re-mark/re-check applications will be amended accordingly and communicated upon the release of the November 2015 results.

Kindly ensure that all candidates are duly informed of the delay in resulting and the arrangements for the first trimester and the first semester of 2016.

The 2016 examinations management plans for NATED Report 190/1 programmes will be released later today.
